

C scale first position Ukulele







C scale can be played as illustrated in the first position. Refer to the tab above or the fret diagram.

Each fret represents a half step so notes that are a whole sep apart are 2 frets apart and notes that are a half step apart are on adjacent frets. Major scales

follow the pattern "whole step, whole step, half step, whole step, whole step, whole step, half step".

Playing the C scale from open C string then, we would play notes on the open string, plus:

2nd, 4th, 5th, 7th, 9th, 11th and 12th frets
