


E pentatonic, major and blues scales

E Major scale is spelled E/F#/G#/A/B/C#/D# and E. In the first position you can start on the open E6 string (1st degree)

E Minor pentatonic (5 tones) scale is spelled 1, b3, 4, 5, b7 and 1 so the notes are E/ G/ A/ B and D In the first position you can start on the open E6 string (1st degree)
