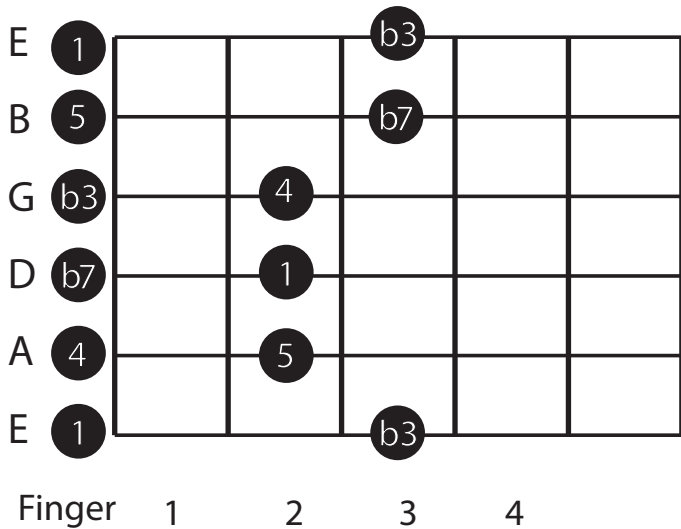
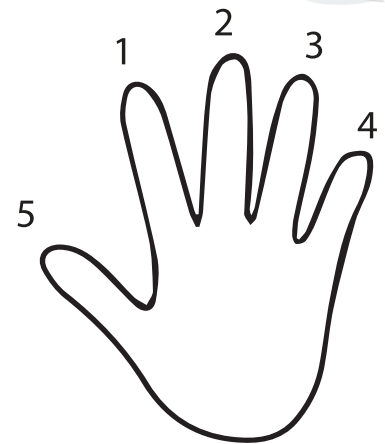
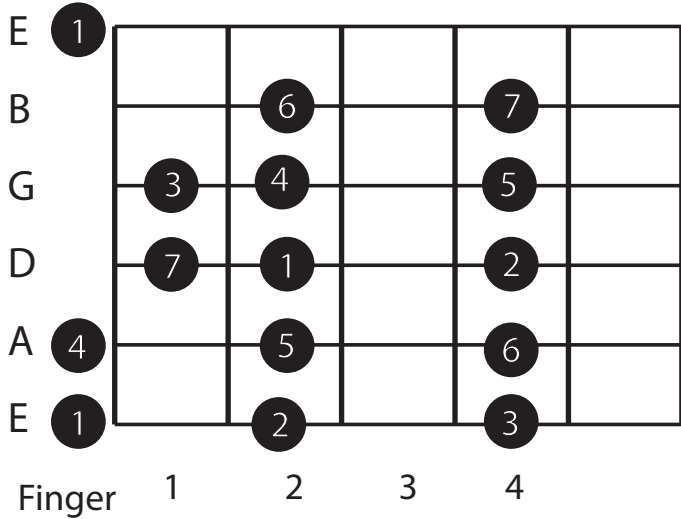
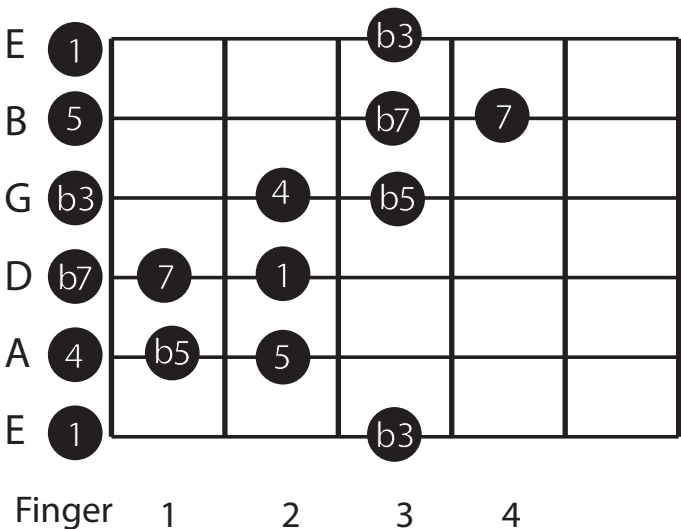


E pentatonic, major and blues scales

E Major scale is spelled E/ F#/ G#/ A/ B/ C#/ D# and E.
In the first position you can start on the open E6 string (1st degree)



E Minor pentatonic (5 tones) scale is spelled 1, b3, 4, 5, b7 and 1 so the notes are E/ G/ A/ B and D
In the first position you can start on the open E6 string (1st degree)



A Minor blues scale includes the blue note and it's spelled 1, b3, 4, b5, 5, b7 and 1.
We can also include the 7 as a passing note.

"Heartbreaker" lick from Zeppelin:
1, b3, 4, b5, 5, b7, 1, 1, 1, 1. b3, 4, b5, b7 enjoy!
