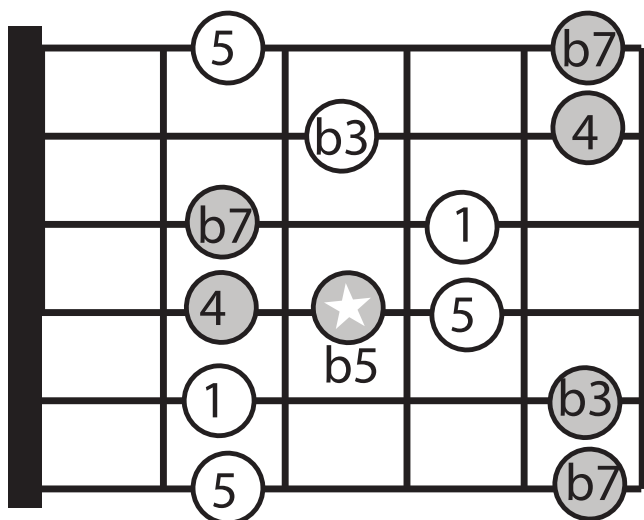


Nutshell in Eb

6 Ebm

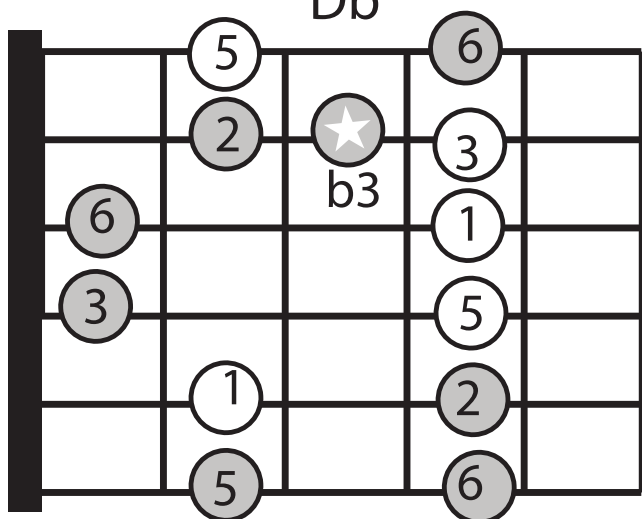


Chord tones in white.

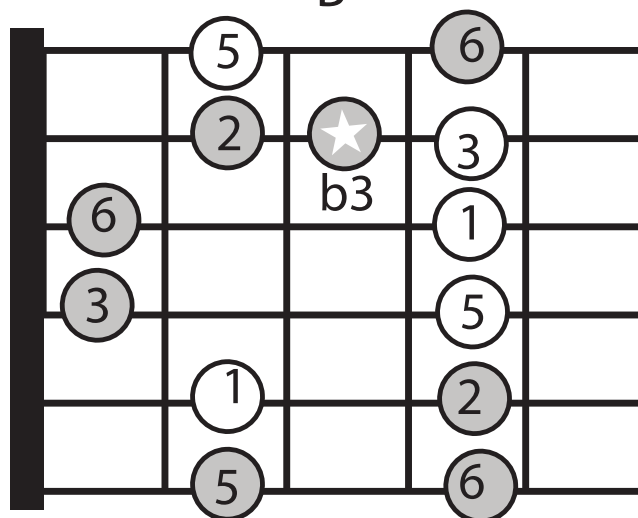
Positions marked as gray can be used with the chord tones over the top of the chord.

These are 'blues' scale notes. The "star" note is additional to the minor pentatonic notes- the b5- and is the "blue" note.

You can see and hear that these notes are not a minor scale. It is still a pentatonic scale though, using 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6. The b3 makes a pretty good passing note here
