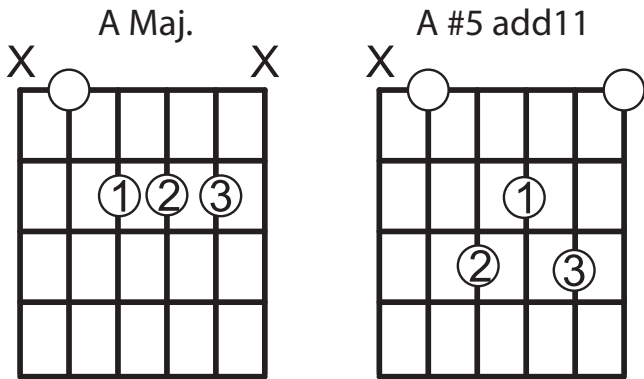


Ten Years Gone



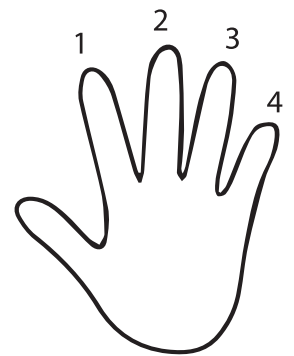

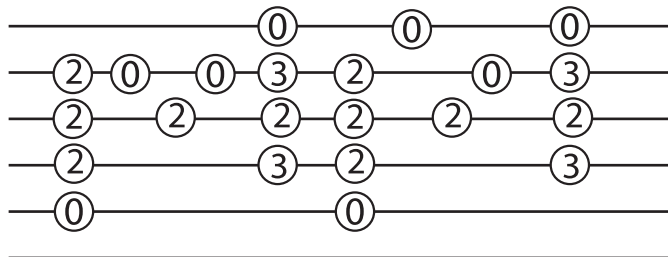

To start, the two chords we need are illustrated above. The A #5 add 11 has a lovely, poignant sound... and a bunch of different names. For the next part, the chord sequence as I hear it is A, C7/A (fifth position) CM7 (3rd position) D and C (first position)
